- 1. Pursuant to OU-LAPP No. 645, s. 2019 dated October 24, 2019, the External Partnerships Service (EPS) in coordination with the Information and Communication Technology Service (ICTS) developed the DepEd Partnerships Database System (DPDS. The purpose of this system is to consolidate the assistance provided to public schools from education stakeholders.
- 2. With this, the reporting of the resources generated shall be reported **MONTHLY**. Please note that the system will stop accepting the reports on the 6th day of the succeeding month. Example: April 2023 resources shall be reported on or before May 6, 2023.
- 3. In addition, when schools do not receive any resources for the month, the School ASP/BE Coordinator shall still download the template and upload it to the system for record purposes.
- 4. School ASP/BE Coordinators can access the site through: https://partnershipsdatabase.deped.gov.ph/. Each school has its own username and password.
