ANNOUNCEMENT OF QUALIFIED ATHLETES, COACHES, ASST. COACHES, CHAPERONS, TRAINERS, DELEGATION OFFICIALS AND OFFICIATING OFFICIALS TO THE 2024 ZAMBOANGA PENINSULA REGIONAL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION (ZPRAA) MEET

1. The Zamboanga Peninsula Regional Athletic Association (ZPRAA) Meet 2024 will be held on **April 21 - 26, 2024**. The activity will be hosted by the Local Government Unit of Zamboanga City.
2. Enclosed is the **list of qualified Athletes, Coaches, Asst. Coaches, Chaperons, Trainers, Officiating Officials, Delegation Officials to the Regional Meet** and carefully selected and recommended by sports specialist assigned as Tournament Managers during the conduct of the 2024 Pagadian City Division Athletic Association (PCDAA) Meet.
3. A **15 – Days QUARTER TRAINING** shall commence on **April 5-19, 2024** at Sta. Lucia National High School as billeting quarter and **8 – Days ZPRAA MEET** on **April 20 – 27, 2024** at Zamboanga City.
 - 3.1. All qualified athletes must engage in actual practice/training with their respective Coaches, Asst. Coaches, Chaperons and Trainers.
 - 3.2. All coaches are expected to submit **PROGRESS REPORT** of the training to the asst. training directors assigned in the event after 5 days of the quarter training.
 - 3.3. Further, it is encouraged that schools which are affected by this activity shall implement flexible learning modality as highlighted by Vice-President and Education Secretary Sara Duterte during her 2023 Basic Education Report. Teacher-Coaches and athlete's teacher concerned are advised to prepare the learning module to be used by the learner-athletes during the entire training. The athletes' academic performance records shall be forwarded to their class advisers and subject teachers of the school where they are originally from at the end of the training program.
 - 3.4 To observe time-on-task pursuant to DepEd Order No.9, s.2005 entitled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith, all Schools Heads are directed to take charge and monitor the classes and that curriculum and instructional delivery shall continue.
