2. That in view thereof, you are all hereby directed to observe, comply and conduct the hereunder activities with the corresponding suggested dates within the prescribed guidelines and mandates in connection with the afore-cited memorandum together with its attachments, to wit:

(MORNING: 8:00-12:00 AM) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Division Federated Supreme <u>Elementary</u> Learner Government (SELG) Elections - To be participated by the School Supreme Elementary Learner Government (SELG) Presidents. (AFTERNOON : 1:00-5:00 PM) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Division Federated Supreme <u>Secondary</u> Learner Government (SSLG) Elections - To be participated by the School Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG) Presidents.
c. May 27- 31, 2024	- Regional Federation LGP Elections (Venue and exact date will be announced later)
d. July 11, 2024	National Federations LGP Elections

3. Abovementioned division personnel are hereby directed to comply and observe the following:

a. School Head/Principal shall monitor the conduct of Homeroom Class Organization/LGP elections facilitated by the respective class advisers duly supervise by the School LGP (SELG/SSLG) Teacher-Adviser and School Youth Formation Coordinator concerned.

b. School LGP (SELG/SSLG) Teacher-Adviser shall facilitate and conduct the school based federated LGP (SELG/SSLG) elections for the set of officers for school year 2024-2025 with the assistance and supervision of the School Youth Formation Coordinator.

c. School LGP (SELG/SSLG) Teacher-Adviser concerned shall submit the name of each school LGP (SELG/SSLG) federation **president**

together with his/her corresponding contact number, active e-mail address and facebook account to Mr. Richel P. Reducto, Project Development Officer-1/Division Youth Formation Coordinator on/or before **May 14, 2024** the names of the school LGP (SELG/SSLG) presidents in preparation for Division Federated LGP (SELG/SSLG) elections this coming **May 21, 2024** at Tomas Sagun Elementary School, San Jose District, Pagadian City.

f. Furthermore, all elementary and secondary school heads/principals through their respective school LGP (SELG/SSLG) Teacher-Adviser concerned shall submit to the office of the undersigned through Mr. Richel P. Reducto, Project Development Officer-1/Division Youth Formation Coordinator on/or before **May 27, 2024** a Narrative Report on the conduct of elections with the corresponding list of school LGP (SELG/SSLG) Set of Officers for School Year 2024-2025.

4. Pursuant to the recently issued Office of the Undersecretary for Operations (OUOPS) Memorandum DM-OUOPS-2024-11-02487 dated March 25, 2024, the undersigned hereby directs Mr. Richel P. Reducto, Project Development Officer-1/Division Youth Formation Coordinator to conduct monitoring on school LGP (SELG/SSLG) elections.

SUBJECT: SCHEDULE OF THE SUPREME ELEMENTARY LEARNER GOVERNMENT (SELG) AND SUPREME SECONDARY LEARNER GOVERNMENT (SSLG) ELECTIONS FOR SCHOOL YEAR (S.Y.) 2024-2025

DATE: March 25, 2024

Under the Department of Education Order (DO) No. 47 s, 2014 titled, "Constitution and Operation of the Supreme Pupil Government and Supreme Student Government in Elementary and Secondary Schools," the Department of Education (DepEd) recognizes that the Student Government Program (SGP), through the Supreme Pupil Government (SPG) and Supreme Student Government (SSG), is the foremost non-commercial learner-led organization authorized to operate and implement pertinent programs, projects, and activities in all schools nationwide.

To ensure consistency under DO No. 21, s. 2019, the SGP shall be named Learner Government Program (LGP) while SPG and SSG will be known as the Supreme Elementary Learner Government (SELG) and Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG), respectively.

The pivotal role of student-led clubs and organizations within the LGP serves as the lifeblood of effective leadership that contributes to the learners' holistic development. Through the SELG and SSLG Elections, the Department aims to amplify the voices of learners for representation and decision-making.

In line with this, the Bureau of Learner Support Services, through the Youth Formation Division (BLS-S-YFD), commits to provide support to all learners to install effective leadership which shall contribute to their holistic development.

Aligned with the preparations for the School Year (S.Y.) 2024-2025, the elections for the SELG and SSLC shall be conducted in the last quarter of S.Y. 2023-2024, following the indicative schedule(s) outlined below:

Suggested Date(s)	Activity
April 15 - May 10, 2024	School-Based Elections
May 15 - 23, 2024	District/Division Elections
May 27 - 31, 2024	Regional Federation Elections
June 11, 2024	National Federation Elections

This activity aims to establish learner representations through the SELG/SSLC across all levels of governance for S.Y. 2024-2025 through an election.

In pursuit of the optimal engagement of all learners, all Schools Division Superintendents (SDSs) and School Heads, through their respective Youth Formation Coordinators (YFCs) and SELG/SSLC Teacher-Advisers, are hereby requested to provide technical assistance and adhere to the Learner Government Election and Appointment Code stipulated on **Annexes A-B**.

Moreover, please be guided that additional provisions were included to highlight the eligible voters for the said elections as well as the inclusion of a unified template for the creation of the General Plan of Action (GPOA).
