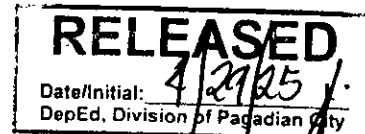

BAWAT BATA MAKABABASA (BBM) PROGRAM IN SDO PAGADIAN CITY

1. The Department of Education, through **DepEd Order 10, 2025**, Titled **Guidelines on the Implementation of the 2025 Department of Education Summer Programs**, the **DM. No. 033, s. 2025: Supplemental Guidelines on the Implementation of Bawat Bata Makababasa Program**, and the **Regional Memorandum No. 209, s. 2025** underscores the urgent need to intensify reading interventions to address learning gaps among early-grade learners and institutionalize reading proficiency programs to support learning recovery. In response, the Bawat Bata Makababasa Program is introduced as an initiative designed to ensure that all struggling readers attain grade-level reading proficiency.
2. The Division of Pagadian City, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), is in full support of the Regional Office IX implementation of the BBM Program.
3. As a kickoff activity of the program, the 277 identified BBM Program Tutors of Pagadian City Division will participate in a one-day training, which will be held in Pagadian City Pilot School, San Jose, Pagadian City on May 2, 2025.
4. Tutors are requested to bring laptops and extension cords for use during the training sessions. To minimize movement outside of the venue, participants are advised to bring their meals (2 snacks and 1 lunch).
