- 1. The Department of Education, through the Bureau of Learning Resources, continues to work on harvesting the best reading resources to support several reading programs such as the "Hamon: Bawat Bata Bumabasa" or Deped Memo 173, series of 2019, the multi-sectoral "Brigada Pagbasa", among other reading initiatives in all governance levels of the system.
- 2. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 32, s. 2015 dated July 19, 2015, paragraph 4 on Key Elements of an Indigenous Peoples Education Curriculum on Learning Resources that Instructional materials and other learning resources shall be developed and utilized in line with the described curriculum content and teaching-learning process.
- 3. The localization of the curriculum can allow learning to become more meaningful and relevant. It supports policy formulation and standard setting for reform of the curriculum and the impact of this on teacher skills and knowledge.
- 4. Teachers continuously fulfill their duties and mandates to produce productive and responsible citizens equipped with essential competencies and skills for lifelong learning. Thus, accepting the challenge by contributing to the treasury of content materials for utilization as reading resources and transformation to engaging media and providing original stories demonstrating learning competencies of the K to 12 basic education curriculums.
- 5. Pagadian City Schools Division through the CID will conduct a Three-Day Division Training Writeshop for Illustrators and Writers of IPEd Contextualized Reading Materials and Lesson Exemplars for Grade-1 Teachers on the Implementation of Project Megbasa Naita on March 12 14, 2025. The venue of the said activity will be announced soon in a separate corrigendum.
- 6. This training writeshop aims to:
 - a. Increase knowledge in localization & indigenization processes in big/small bookmaking using Central Subanen Orthography (SCO).
 - b. Finalize the illustration for big/small Books written by the selected Kinder and Grade-1teachers, and School Heads in 2019.
 - c. Apply the knowledge and skills in preparing a contextualized lesson exemplar.

- 7. The Participants are the following:
 - a. 14 Grade I Teachers of Schools serving in IPEd community
 - b. 37 Illustrators
 - c. 5 Program Management Teams (CID Chief, Program Proponents, Quality Assurers, Resource Speakers/Learning Facilitators, and staff)
- 8. Meals & snacks, travel of tribal leaders, training supplies, materials & other expenses during the training/writeshop will be charged against 2024 IPEd PSF, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 9.
