**STRENGTHENING SAFE SPACES: A 2025 DIVISION-WIDE SEMINAR ON ANTI-ONLINE SEXUAL ABUSE OR EXPLOITATION OF CHILDREN (OSAEC), CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE OR EXPLOITATION (CSAEM), AND THE SAFE SPACES ACT**

1. In accordance with Republic Act No. 11930, the "Anti-Online Sexual Abuse or Exploitation of Children (OSAEC) and Child Sexual Abuse or Exploitation Materials (CSAEM) Act," and Republic Act No. 11313, the "Safe Spaces Act," the Schools Division Office of Pagadian City, in partnership with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Pagadian City, will conduct **Strengthening Safe Spaces: A 2025 Division-Wide Seminar on Anti-Online Sexual Abuse or Exploitation of Children (OSAEC), Child Sexual Abuse or Exploitation (CSAEM), and the Safe Spaces Act** on **March 26, 2025, at Bay Plaza Hotel, Pagadian City.**
2. The seminar aims to:
  - a. Raise awareness about the provisions and significance of Republic Act No. 11930 and Republic Act No. 11313.
  - b. Equip participants with the knowledge and skills necessary to identify, prevent, and respond to cases of online sexual abuse, exploitation, and other forms of violence.
  - c. Promote a culture of safety, respect, and equality within schools and the wider community.
  - d. Strengthen the role of educators and school personnel as protectors and advocates for the rights and welfare of children and vulnerable individuals.
3. Participants in this activity are **all Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads**. Enclosed is the list of participants and members of the Program Management Team.
4. In addition to the division-wide seminar, the Schools Division Office will also conduct a short orientation on the **Classroom-Based Session Against Online Sexual Abuse or Exploitation of Children (OSAEC) and Child Sexual Abuse or Exploitation Materials (CSAEM)** in reference to **CM-OUOPS-2025-11-01288 dated February 19, 2025**. All concerned parties are directed to carry out these sessions to enhance awareness and preventive measures against OSAEC and CSAEM.
5. To ensure the effective implementation of this initiative in schools, instructional classroom-based sessions will be conducted for each key stage and delivered by class advisers during their Homeroom Guidance subject.
